International Wine Competition in Zurich: 13 Geneva Vintages Win Medals!

During the 18th International Expovina Wine Competition that took place from 19 to 22 July 2011 in Zurich, 13 Geneva wines received awards.

This year, 2,319 wines, mostly Swiss but also from Europe and the new world, were tasted by 150 jury members who awarded 174 gold medals and 563 silver medals.

Two Geneva wineries received gold medals: Domaine Les Perrières, which received awards both for its Chardonnay 2009 and its Aligoté 2010; and the Cave de Genève, which won gold for the red Merlot-Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 blend that is part of its “Vins de Philippe Chevrier” range.

Geneva recipients of silver medals were the Domaine des Chouans; Le Clos de Céligny; the Domaine des Abeilles d'Or, and the Domaine des Alouettes.
