Geneva Wines Win Gold and Silver in Paris

At the 17th Vinalies Internationales wine competition, held in Paris from February 25 to March 1 2011, over 3,000 wines were tasted and rated by a group of wine experts from around the world.

Geneva wine makers won five medals, two gold and three silver. The two gold medals were awarded to La Cave de Genève for its 2009 Merlot, *La Tour Maîtresse*, and for its 2009 oak-aged red blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon from the *Philippe Chevrier Wine Collection*. Chevrier is a Geneva chef whose restaurant, *Domaine de Châteauevieux* in Satigny, rates two Michelin stars.

La Cave de Genève also won two silver medals for its dessert wine *Intuition* (2009) and 2009 Gamaret *La Clémence*. The third silver medal went to *Domaine du Paradis* for its 2009 oak-aged Sauvignon Blanc.
