Geneva Wines Win Gold in Paris!

A Gamaret and a Sauvignon come out on top

The 16th "Vinalies Internationales" annual wine contest took place from February 26 to March 2, 2010, in Paris. Over 3,000 vintages were tasted and judged by a group of top international wine experts.

Geneva wines took no less than four medals at the high-profile event, which is officially recognized by the Paris-based, governmental International Organisation of Vine and Wine (OIV). Besides the two gold medals awarded to Cave des Bossons's 2008 Sauvignon Gris and Domaine des Charmes's 2007 Gamaret were silver medals for two Cave de Genève wines: a sweet white blend, "Intuition" (2008), and "Trésor", a 2008 Chardonnay.

In general, Swiss wines did exceptionally well at the contest.
